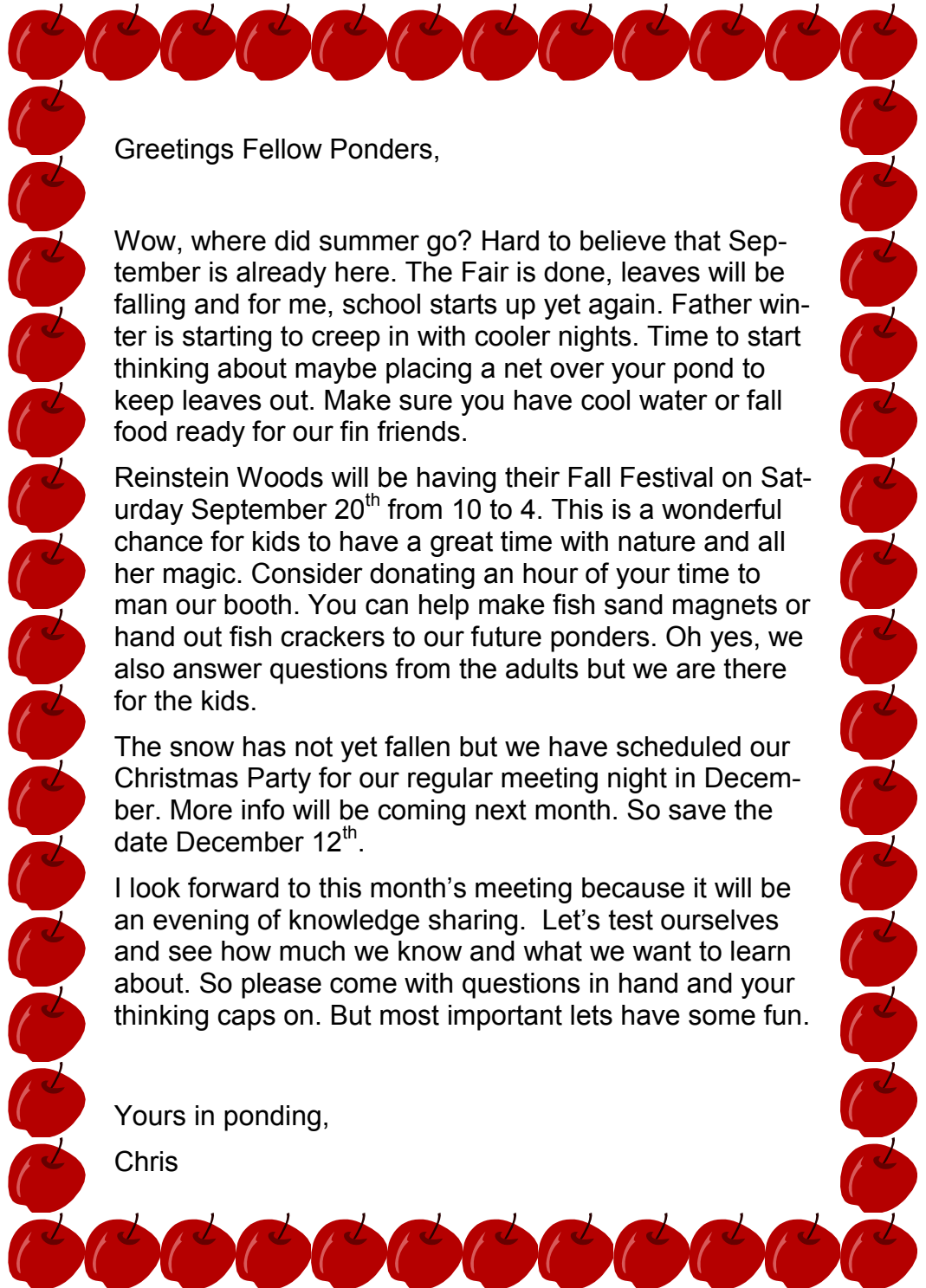

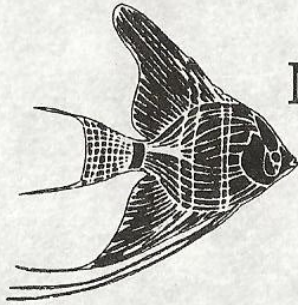
Erie County Fair 2014
